Guide for each day

 - Write, in your own words, what the passage plainly says.
 - Then write out what it means.
3. Application:
 - After you find out what the passage says and means, it is vital that you write out how it applies to your life. Unapplied knowledge is useless.
4. Prayer:
 - Pray that during the day that you'll be reminded about what you looked at in the Bible and that you will apply these principles from God's word to your life.
